This interuniversity master's degree program is the continuation of the URV-specific degree in Anthropology of Medicine (1994-2000), and the URV master's degree in Medical Anthropology and International Health (2005-2014).

Its aim is to provide students with a solid foundation in the theories, techniques and methodologies of medical anthropology. On graduating they should be able to translate social problems into anthropological research questions and transform the research into policy recommendations, thus contributing to social innovation and the development of new health care models.

This two-year program is unique in southern Europe, and constitutes a link between Europe, Latin America and African countries. The languages of instruction are Spanish and Catalan; some required reading in English.

### CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

This program aims to train students to join the labor market in the following areas:

- 1. Public-sector and private-sector health care assessment agencies
- 2. International health, health promotion and education, and public health
- 3. Preparation for admission to doctoral programs of study and eventual teaching in universities, medical schools or social work programs
- 4. Health care management and planning
- 5. Cultural psychiatry and psychology
- 6. High-level international research on global health
